METAL HELMET

Helmets from the late Roman period were made of metals like SILVER, GOLD, AND IRON. Some were even gilded and decorated with JEWELS AND GEMS!

> This helmet has CHEEKPIECES hanging down from both sides. Other helmets might also include nosepieces and neck guards. Each element was DESIGNED TO PROVIDE ULTIMATE PROTECTION to the person wearing the helmet.

In the book of EPHESIANS, Paul instructs believers to put on the FULL ARMOR OF GOD so they can stand against the enemy's schemes. Check out EPHESIANS 6:17 to learn more about the HELMET OF SALVATION!

WHAT IS AN AMBASSADOR?

AN AMBASSADOR IS SOMEONE WHO REPRESENTS ANOTHER PERSON OR THING.

Countries often have ambassadors. These people are high-ranking diplomats, representing their country in other countries. They work together with other countries' ambassadors to protect citizens and promote prosperity and peace. Ambassadors must be strong and respected leaders who communicate well with others.

> Paul explained that he was an ambassador of the gospel. He asked the Ephesians to pray that he would be a strong communicator and that he would represent the gospel well.










