BIBLE STORY NUGGETS

- Paul loved God.

PAUL'S GOOD NEWS

Romans 1

Paul traveled to many cities to talk to people about Jesus. Paul loved Jesus and knew that God sent Jesus to help people.

Paul wanted to visit the city of Rome. There were many churches in Rome, and Paul knew the church people were telling more and more people about Jesus. Paul wanted to tell the Roman friends about his work and ask them to help him.

Paul wrote a letter to the church people. Paul told the people that he prayed for them. Paul reminded the church people that God wants everyone to worship Him and know His Son, Jesus. Paul said, “God sent Jesus to help people. This good news is for everyone.”

FAMILY ADVENTURE SING ABOUT GOOD NEWS

Young children learn from hearing their name over and over. Sing this song to your baby (tune “Mary Had a Little Lamb”) and use his name. *The good news is for everyone, everyone, everyone. The good news is for everyone, the good news is for (child's name).*

Show your baby the picture on this card and say Paul's name.

FAMILY ADVENTURE PHONE A FRIEND

Your toddler can give a message to others just as Paul did. Telephone a family member or friend your preschooler knows. Invite your toddler to speak to the person and say words such as: *I love you, God loves you, Jesus helps you,* or other phrases. After the call, affirm your toddler for sharing good news with someone. Show Paul's picture and tell the Bible story.
