Suggested Week of Use: May 8, 2022
Core Passage: 2 Thess. 1:3-12

News Story Summary

Various reports have emerged about paramedics and first responders continuing to do their work in and around Kharkiv, Ukraine despite the danger. They find themselves running into danger, learning how to anticipate the double-hit attacks that are prevalent in the area. When asked about continuing to do this work during the Russian attacks, Vladimir Venzel, a 25-year-old paramedic, remarked that he is determined to keep doing what he is doing and vowed to do so until the end of the war and beyond.

Focus Attention
