

Session 13: Waiting Suggested Week of Use: May 29, 2022 Core Passage: 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15

News Story Summary

Denzel Irving, a 26-year-old assistant North Carolina high school football coach, was diagnosed with a failing heart in late March and has placed on a waiting list for a transplant. Irving endured seven surgeries while waiting and suffered a stroke. He told of singing gospel songs and thinking about his daughter as he waited for the transplant. In addition to relying on his faith, Irving worked with a financial advisor, and drew from the support and love from his family and the Charlotte community. Nearly 700 donors contributed close to \$50,000 to cover his medical costs through GoFundMe. Within a month, a heart transplant was performed, and Irving walked out of the hospital six days later.

Focus Attention

Summarize and Challenge

Invite the group to propose ways Coach Irvin's attitude may have impacted others as he waited. Ask: *How does what we do when waiting reveal our priorities?*
