Allergy Sign

Several exploration activities in the Leader Guide sessions include foods, plants, animals, or other nature items. Some children in your class may have allergies to these items. Whenever you plan to use nature items, inform parents ahead of time. Write the name of the nature item being used. Post the sign on the door for parents' attention.

CIRCLE TIME

GATHER

- Quietly play music to get toddlers' attention. Walk on the footprint path made earlier to lead the children to the Circle Time area.
- When children are seated, play one more song and invite toddlers to clap along.
- Remark: "Thank you for walking with me to Circle Time. Let's listen to a story about someone walking to towns to tell important news."

HEAR THE BIBLE STORY

- Open the Bible to John 1 and tell today's Bible story in your own words. Keep the story brief.
- Pass the Story Picture (Pack Item
 1) around the circle. As children
 look at the picture, ask: "What was
 John's important news?"
- Lead children to say: "Jesus is God's Son."

PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Place today's marker (Pack Item 18) in the Bible with a portion of the marker visible when the Bible is closed.
- Say: "The Bible is a special book. The Bible tells about Jesus."
- Open the Bible to the marker and show it to children. Say: "These words are in the Bible."
- Toss a beanbag to each child and give him a turn to say the Bible verse or the name *John* or *Jesus*.

PRAY

 Pray briefly. Say something simple like: "Thank You, God, for sending Your Son, Jesus, to help people."



MATCH BIBLES TO OUTLINES

Tools: Bible, large piece of poster board, washable marker, 3-5 Bibles in various sizes, Preschool Family Card

- Lay the Bibles and Family Card on the poster board. Trace an outline around each item. Put the Bibles and Family Card on the floor with the poster board.
- Invite a child to look at each Bible. Talk about the similarities and differences.
- Direct the toddler to lay each item on its corresponding outline.
- Open one Bible to the book of John. Say: "Some Bibles have different covers. Some Bibles are different sizes. All Bibles tell us that Jesus is God's Son."

ROLL CARS ON ROADS

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, 2-3 sentence strips, marker, several toy cars, tape

- Print the words of today's Text Truth on the sentence strips. Tape the strips to the floor to make roadways.
- Give a toddler a choice of car to roll over the paper strips. Read the words on the strip as the child pushes his car on the road.
- Show the toddler the picture on the Diaper Bag Card. Point to John and remark that John told people that Jesus is God' Son.
- Open the Bible to John 1 and point to John's name. Comment: "John had important news to tell!"

PUSH PICTURES INTO A BOX

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: John Told About Jesus (Pack Item 1), shoebox, craft knife (teacher's use), Jesus Mobile Pictures (Pack Item 21)

- Use the craft knife to make a long slit in the lid of the shoebox.
 Tear apart the Mobile Pictures and put them next to the box.
- When a toddler notices the box and pictures, invite her to choose a picture of Jesus to push into the box. Talk about the picture and comment that Jesus loved people and cared about them. Say: "Jesus loves you, too."
- Sing the song "Jesus Loves Me" as the child pushes pictures through the slot in the box. After all the pictures are in the box, tell the child to pour them out so a friend can have a turn.
- Show the Story Picture and summarize the Bible story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

CIRCLE TIME

GATHER

- Lay four sheets of paper together to form a large square. Tape an Actions Card (Pack Item 28) in the center of each paper.
- Play music as toddlers move with you to the Circle Time area.
- Describe the various actions shown on the cards. Invite children to take turns tossing a beanbag onto a colored square and completing the action.
- When everyone has had at least one turn, toss the beanbag toward the Bible. Say: "The Bible tells about a man named Nicodemus.
 Let's hear what Nicodemus did."

PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- To the tune "London Bridge," sing: Nicodemus came at night, came at night, came at night. Nicodemus came at night, to see Jesus.
- Guide the toddler seated next to you to open the Bible to the Bible marker (Pack Item 18). Read the verse on the marker. Guide the child to repeat the verse with you and then close the Bible.
- Pass the Bible around the circle, giving each child a turn to hold the Bible and say the verse.
- Afterward, remark: "God sent Jesus to help all people. God wants all people to believe in Jesus."

HEAR THE BIBLE STORY

- Hold the Bible open to John 3 as you recall today's Bible story.
- Show the Story Picture (Pack Item 2) to each child and point to Nicodemus and Jesus.
- Lead children to repeat the name *Nicodemus* several times.

PRAY

 Pray: "Thank You, God, for sending Jesus to help all people. Thank You, God, for the true stories in the Bible that help us learn about You and Your Son, Jesus."



SORT COLORS

Tools: Bible, large colorful foam blocks, plastic pan, construction paper in colors matching the blocks, Colors Cube (Pack Item 25), Preschool Family Card

- Spread the paper around the pan of colored foam blocks. Hide the Family Card among the blocks.
- Toss the Colors Cube and name the color. Suggest that a child look for blocks that are the same color. Guide the child to put blocks on the same color of paper.
- Help young toddlers as needed.
- When a child discovers the Family Card, take a moment to look at it and recall the Bible story.

BALANCE & WALK

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, smooth wood plank or wide masking tape

- Put the plank in an open space where children have room to walk and balance. (Make a tape line on the floor if you do not have a plank.)
- While toddlers take turns walking on the plank or tape line, talk about Nicodemus walking through the streets to find Jesus.
- Say: "Nicodemus wanted to ask Jesus some questions. Jesus helped Nicodemus know what he should do."
- Show children the picture on the Diaper Bag Card and call on a child to point to Nicodemus. Turn to John 3 and find Nicodemus' name

PLAY OUT A BEDTIME ROUTINE

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus Talked to Nicodemus (Pack Item 2), small pillow, blanket or child's sleeping bag, baby doll

- As toddlers peruse the items, say: "Nighttime is when most people go to sleep. What do you do to get ready for bed?"
- · Help children describe some actions such as brush teeth, put on pajamas, look at books, or pray with a family member.
- Invite a few toddlers to play out a bedtime routine for themselves or the baby doll. Afterward, show the Story Picture. Remark that Nicodemus looked for Jesus at nighttime.
- Tell the Bible story briefly. Hold the Bible open to John 3:16 and add: "These words in the Bible tell us to believe in Jesus. Thank You, God, for Jesus."

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and **Preschool Family Card in each** child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

☆CIRCLE TIME

GATHER

- Play music as you walk around the room. Invite toddlers to walk with you while the music plays. Say: "Stand still when the music stops."
- After a few rounds, go to the Circle Time area, stop the music, and tell children to sit down.
- Remark: "You walked a long way. You listened well, too, and stopped every time the music stopped."
- Continue: "Our Bible story is about a woman who walked to a well to get water. She listened when Jesus told her about God's love."

HEAR THE BIBLE STORY

- Hold the Bible open at John 4 as you tell today's Bible story.
- Show the Story Picture (Pack Item 3) and ask simple questions: Did the woman go to the well to get some milk? (No) Did Jesus talk to the woman? (Yes) Did the woman drive back to town in her car? (No)

Did the woman tell the people in the town about Jesus? (Yes) Did the people learn that God loved them and sent Jesus to show them His love? (Yes)

PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Place today's marker (Pack Item 18) in the Bible at 1 John 4:9.
- Play music as the children pass the Bible around the circle. Pause the music and tell the child holding the Bible to open the Bible to the marker.
- Say: "The Bible tells us about Jesus. These words say that God loved us and sent Jesus."
- Close the Bible and start the music again. Continue until everyone has a turn to open the Bible.

PRAY

• Say thank you to God for loving people. Include each child's name in the thank-you prayer.



BOWL OVER BOTTLES

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, several empty plastic water bottles, large foam ball

- Lay the Diaper Bag Card on the Bible and place it near the water bottles.
- Arrange the bottles near a wall for a bowling game.
- Give a child the ball. Invite him to bowl over the bottles.
- Exclaim: "Good job! You knocked over all the bottles."
- After several children have turns to bowl, put away the ball and look at the Diaper Bag Card together. Summarize the story about a woman getting water at a well.

PLAY A MESSAGE RELAY

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: A Woman Heard About God's Love (Pack Item 3), September Bible Markers (Pack Item 18)

- Invite 4-5 children to play a message relay. Position the children in different locations in the room.
- Give today's marker to a child. Read the Bible verse to the child. Say: "Please relay (take) this message to a friend in the room. Tell your friend the message."
- Guide children to deliver the marker to others and tell them the message.
- After everyone has a turn to relay the message, sit down to look at the Story Picture and recall the Bible story.

DECORATE A BIBLE VERSE HANGER

Tools: Bible, Music & Print Extras, poster board squares, crayons, washable markers, colorful stickers, hole punch, ribbon strips

- Write today's Bible verse on the squares. Punch a hole in the top of each square and tie a ribbon through the hole.
- Give each toddler a square. Read the Bible verse. Invite the child to decorate his Bible verse square however he wishes. While the child works, play music and listen for songs about Jesus and God.
- Say: "Songs help us think about Jesus and God's love. God sent Jesus to help people and show God's love to them."
- Tell toddlers they may take their Bible verse hangers home to remind them that Jesus showed God's love to people.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

CIRCLE TIME

GATHER

- Cut squares of colored paper. Tape the squares to the floor in a circle. Place the four September markers (Pack Item 18) in the Bible.
- Play songs about Jesus and encourage toddlers to step from square to square around the circle.
- Stop the music and name a child to tell the color on which he is standing. Next, tell the child to find a marker in the Bible.
- Read the verse aloud and replace the marker. Continue until everyone has chosen a marker.

HEAR THE BIBLE STORY

- Comment: "Our Bible story is about a man who could not see colors or people or anything.
 Listen to hear what happened to the man."
- With the Bible open to John 9, tell today's Bible story.
- Pass the Story Picture (Pack Item
 4) around the circle.

PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Give each child a Bible to hold.
- State: "The Bible is a special book. Show me how to open the Bible gently."
- Commend children for being careful with the special book.
 Encourage everyone to open and close the Bible several times.
- Ask: "What do we call this special book?" Lead toddlers to say the word *Bible* with you.
- Turn to John 12:46 and say today's Bible verse.

PRAY

- Pray: "Thank You, God, for sending Jesus."
- To the tune "The Farmer in the Dell," sing:
 - Jesus came to help, Yes, Jesus came to help. He helped the man who could not see. Yes, Jesus came to help.

WASH A BABY DOLL

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, baby doll, bath sponge, towel, baby wipes, Music & Print Extras

- Invite a toddler to wash the baby doll using the sponge or wipes.
- Show the picture on the Diaper Bag Card. Mention that Jesus made a special mud to place on the man's eyes. Then Jesus told the man to go wash in the pool.
- Comment: "Jesus came to help people know and love God. Jesus helped the man and made his eyes well."
- As the child takes care of the doll, play songs about Jesus.

UNCOVER A BIBLE PICTURE

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus Helped a Man (Pack Item 4), assorted colors of sticky notes

- Cover the Story Picture with different colors of sticky notes. Put a sticky note in the Bible at John 9.
- Give the picture to a child and invite him to pull away a blue sticky. Name another color sticky for the child to remove. After a while, ask the child what he can tell you about the picture.
- Say: "Good job finding colors of sticky notes. You can see with your eyes. Do you recall a story about a man who could not see?" Tell the child to turn to the sticky note in the Bible. Recall the story.

READ ABOUT JESUS

Tools: CSB® Read to Me Bible, Preschool Family Card, Jesus Mobile Pictures (Pack Item 21), Book: Jesus Helped People (Pack Item 31), other books about Jesus, soft blanket or cushions

- Tuck the Family Card and pictures of Jesus in various locations in the Bible. Use the blanket or cushions to make a comfy reading space. Nearby, add the Bible and books about Jesus.
- As you look at books with a toddler, say: "These books tell about Jesus. The Bible is a special book. It tells about Jesus, too."
- Open the Bible and suggest: "Let's look for pictures of Jesus."
 Talk about ways Jesus helped people as shown in pictures.
- When the child finds the Family Card, recall today's Bible story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

Tools: Bible, wooden puzzles showing families or people, Preschool Family Card, Heart Lacing Card (Pack Item 22), Book: Jesus Helped People (Pack Item 31)

- Encourage a child to choose a puzzle to work or she may enjoy lacing the Heart Card. Use the puzzles to lead to conversation about Jesus loving people and helping them. Mention that Jesus loved Lazarus and Lazarus' sisters trusted Jesus to help their brother.
- Picture-read the book to a child. Comment: "Jesus wanted people to know that God sent Jesus to help people. We can trust that Jesus will help us."
- Show children the Family Card.

GROUP HELPER VEHICLES

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus Healed Lazarus (Pack Item 5), 2 or more of each type of community helper vehicle (fire truck, police car, tow truck, ambulance, so on), shallow box

- Lay the Story Picture in the box and cover it with the vehicles.
 Invite a child to choose a toy vehicle. Say: "You are playing with a fire truck. Can you find another fire truck?"
- Mention that fire trucks and other vehicles are used to help people when they are sick or injured or need help.
- Show the Story Picture. Explain: "In Bible times, Jesus helped people who were sick. Jesus' friend Lazarus was very, very sick. Jesus walked to Lazarus' house and made Lazarus well."
- Guide children to group types of helper vehicles.

- Ask preschoolers what they do at home to show love. Thank the children for being helpful and loving.
- Join the children's play. Suggest: "Making lunch is a way to show love. What would you like to cook today?"
- As a toddler brings you an imaginary meal, thank God for the food.
- Help children repeat today's Bible verse.

BUILD WITH BLOCKS

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: A Letter About Love (Pack Item 6), cardboard blocks or large plastic bricks, toy people figures

- Begin moving a few blocks and stacking them to get toddlers' attention. Suggest: "I'm building a house for the people. Would you like to help me?"
- As the child stacks blocks and builds, comment: "You are helping. You are showing love."
- Open the Bible to 1 John. Say: "A man named John wrote about showing love. John said to love one another."
- Show the child the picture of John writing his letter. Recall the Bible story.
- Find 1 John 3:23 and lead the child to say today's Bible verse.

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, Story Picture: God Cared for His People (Pack Item 10), Preschool Family Card, beanbags, tape

- Lay the items on the floor about a foot apart. Make a tape line on the floor about 3 feet from the items.
- Invite toddlers to toss beanbags to land on the pictures or Bible. Cheer for the children as they work at this task.
- In between tosses, review the Bible story.
 Comment that Moses helped God's people remember how much God loved and cared for them.
- After a while, open the Bible to the story passage and point to Moses' name.

PLAY A COLORS GAME

Tools: Bible, Preschool Family Card, Colors Cube (Pack Item 25), Colors & Pictures Game (Pack Item 33)

- This is a simple game which toddlers can do alone or with one friend.
- Tell a child to toss the Colors Cube, then move a token to the color block that matches the Cube color facing up. Next, direct the preschooler to point to the small gameboard picture bordered by the same color.
- Talk with the child about the item and how it might be used to learn about the Bible, God, or Jesus. Finally, suggest that the child look for a similar item in your room.
- Show the Family Card and help the child recall today's story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

- Say: "Good job following the instructions. Our story is about following instructions, or laws. Listen carefully."
- Open the Bible to Deuteronomy 5 and tell the Bible story.
- Show toddlers the Story Picture (Pack Item 11) and pass it around the circle.
- Ask a few questions to help children think about the story: Who was the leader of God's people? (Moses)

What did Moses tell the people to remember? (what God did for them, how God helped the people)
What did God give to the people? (laws to obey)

PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Pass the Bible around the circle as music plays. Pause the music and tell the toddler holding the Bible to open it to a ribbon marker placed at Deuteronomy 6:17.
- Ask the group: "What did Moses tell the people to do?" Lead everyone to repeat: "Obey God's commands."
- If time allows, give every child a turn to hold the Bible.

PRAY

- Pray, thanking God for the Bible and for the laws God gave to help people.
- Ask God to help families obey God's commands.



DRAW WITH MARKERS

Tools: Bible, large piece of paper, washable markers, Diaper Bag Card, tape, yellow crayon

- Tape the paper to a table. Lay the Diaper Bag Card in the center of the paper. Open the Bible to Deuteronomy 6:17. Highlight the words of the Bible verse.
- Offer a few markers to toddlers who want to draw. As children draw, point to the picture on the Diaper Bag Card.
- Say: "God loved the people and wanted to help them. God made some laws, and He told Moses to tell the people to obey God's laws."
- Find the Bible verse and say it together.

ARRANGE BIBLE WORD PLATES

Tools: Bible, 4 solid-colored paper plates, washable marker, paper

- Write today's Bible verse on the paper. Then write one word of the verse on each of three plates. On the fourth plate, write the Bible verse reference.
- Read the words on the paper to a child. Then tell him that the plates have the same words. Guide the child to put the paper plates in order. Assist as needed.
- Say the words as the child lays the plates in sequence.
- Help the toddler say the Bible verse. Then help the child find the verse in the Bible.

MAKE AN "O" BRACELET

Tools: Bible, O-shaped cereal (non-sweetened), chenille stems, tape, Allergy Sign (Music & Print Extras), Story Picture: Laws for God's People (Pack Item 11)

- Post the sign outside the door to tell parents about the cereal.
- Invite a toddler to make a bracelet by threading *O*-shaped cereal onto a chenille stem. When several *O*s are on the stem, twist the ends together to make a bracelet for the child. Use the tape to cover the stem ends.
- Say: "See the letter O. It is the first letter of the word Obey. Moses told the people to obey God's commands."
- Show the Story Picture and guide the child to point to Moses and the people.
- Turn to Deuteronomy 6:17 and find the word obey.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

- Suggest that a child use the dot stickers to make a happy face on his paper.
 A child might want to use the crayons to draw the face or decorate it.
- Show the picture on the Family Card and ask the preschooler to point to smiles on the people's faces.
- Say: "The people look happy to be preparing for a special festival."
 Summarize the Bible story for the child.
- Play music and sing songs to praise God for His goodness.

WORK PUZZLES

Tools: Bible, Celebrations Picture Puzzles (Pack Item 32), self-adhesive magnetic tape, metal cookie pan, scissors

- Cut small pieces of the magnetic tape to put on the backs of the puzzle pieces.
- Lay the cookie pan on a table with the Bible opened to Psalm 100:4b.
- As a preschooler completes a puzzle picture on the pan, talk about the celebration that is shown.
- Touch the Bible pages as you comment:
 "The Bible tells us to celebrate God and give thanks to Him."
- Recall today's Bible story about festivals to celebrate God.

ROLL A BALL & SAY THE VERSE

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, medium-sized playground ball

- Invite children to sit on the floor with you and form a circle.
- Review today's Bible story. Comment that Moses told the people to have special festivals to celebrate God's goodness.
- Pass the Diaper Bag Card around the circle, then return it to the center.
- Choose a child in the circle, call his name, and roll the ball to him. Say the Bible verse: "Give thanks to God. Psalm 100:4b." Encourage the preschooler to repeat the verse, then roll the ball back to you.
- Continue rolling the ball and saying the verse until every child has had a turn.

- Make a final diaper check.

Tools: Bible, large cardboard box, crayons, washable markers

- Invite children to decorate the box.

 Remark: "People use boxes like this one to pack their belongings when they move to another place."
- Add: "Packing and moving reminds me of the Bible story. God's people had followed Moses from Egypt to Canaan. Then Joshua became the new leader. Joshua led the people to their new home in Canaan."
 - Turn to Deuteronomy 31:8 and say the Bible verse. Remark: "Just as God was with Joshua, God is with us, too."

TRACE HANDS

Tools: Bible, paper, pencil, crayons, stickers (opt.)

- Using a pencil, trace around a child's hands on a piece of paper. Print the child's name on the paper.
- Encourage the toddler to use crayons and stickers to decorate his hands.
- Talk about ways toddlers use their hands.
 Say: "One way to use your hands is to turn the pages of the Bible. The Bible helps you learn about God. You can read in the Bible that God will be with you."
- Help a child open the Bible to Deuteronomy 31:8 to find today's verse.

WALK AROUND WORD BLOCKS

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: A New Leader (Pack Item 13), sticky note sheets, marker, tape, blocks, Footprints (Music & Print Extras)

- Print the words of today's Text Truth or Bible verse on individual sticky notes. Tape the notes to wooden or cardboard blocks.
- Lay the blocks on the floor about a foot apart. In between the word blocks, tape the Footprints to make a path.

HEAR & REPEAT SOUNDS

Tools: Bible, Fall Bible Markers (Pack Item 17)

- Vocalize several noises and lead boys and girls to repeat the sounds. Make silly sounds, animal calls, loud and quiet noises. Ask a few volunteers to make sounds while others echo them.
- Tell preschoolers that people followed John and listened to him until John saw Jesus. Then John told people not to look for Jesus to come—He had already come!
- Remark: "John told his disciples that Jesus is the Son of God, so John's disciples began to follow Jesus."
- Ask a child to help you find today's Bible marker at John 1 in the Bible. Read verse 34 and invite children to repeat it after you.

MAKE A MEGAPHONE

Tools: Bible, construction paper, tape, stickers, washable markers, Preschool Family Card

- Offer paper, markers, and stickers to preschoolers.
 Guide a child to decorate his paper and roll it into a cone shape and secure it with tape.
- As the child makes his megaphone, remark that people often use a megaphone to shout important news. Turn to John 1 and tell the child: "John had important news to tell! He helped people get ready for Jesus to come."
- Show the child the picture on the Family Card, then direct the child to speak through his megaphone to say today's Bible verse or Text Truth.

RUN A MESSAGE RELAY

Tools: Bible, masking tape, Story Picture: John Told About Jesus (Pack Item 1)

- Remind children that John was a messenger. God told John to help people get ready for Jesus. Say:
 "Let's pretend you are a messenger. Please take this picture to a friend. Point to Jesus and say, 'Jesus is God's Son.'"
- Tape a starting line on the floor. Give the Bible to the child and instruct her to move quickly to a friend and relay the message.
- Give children turns being the "messenger."

TWIST & BEND CHENILLE STEMS

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: John Told About Jesus (Pack Item 1), thick chenille stems, Bible Word Cards (Pack Item 18)

- Show a child the Word Card for Jesus' name. Use your finger to move over the letters as you say them.
- Guide the child to bend chenille stems to make the letters that spell Jesus' name. Let the child do as much as he can by himself, but offer some guidance if necessary.
- Some children will want to make all the letters. Others may want to make only the letter *J*.
- Say: "We read in the Bible about Jesus. John wrote about Jesus. John helped people know that Jesus is God's Son and Jesus came to help people."
- Show the Story Picture and summarize the Bible story.

SPELL WORDS

Tools: Bible, wooden or plastic letter tiles, Preschool Family Card, index cards, marker

- Print the words *Bible, God, Jesus, Nicodemus, believe,* and *John* on cards. Put the Family Card in the Bible to mark John 3.
- Show a word card to a preschooler. Say the word, then name the letters. Suggest that the child locate letter tiles to spell the word. Connect the word to today's Bible story and verse.
- Help a preschooler open the Bible to John 3. Look at the Family Card picture and say: "Jesus talked to Nicodemus. Jesus helped Nicodemus understand that Jesus came to help people."

MAKE A NIGHTTIME PICTURE

Tools: Bible, black or navy paper, star-shaped stickers, metallic-colored markers

- Use a metallic marker to print the Bible verse on each child's paper.
- Offer paper and star stickers to preschoolers. Suggest that a preschooler make a nighttime picture. Assist a child as she peels a sticker from its backing and attaches it to her paper.
- Point to the Bible verse written on the child's paper and read it. Open the Bible to John 3:16 and point to the words.
- Say: "Your nighttime picture helps me remember Nicodemus and the questions he asked Jesus. Jesus helped Nicodemus know that God sent Jesus to help all people. Jesus said to believe in Him."

ROLL A BALL

Tools: Bible, large ball, Fall Bible Markers (Pack Item 17), masking tape

- Make a large tape circle on the floor and lay today's Bible marker in the center.
- Invite several children to sit on the tape circle. Call their attention to the Bible marker and say the verse.
 Tell children: "Let's learn those words. When I roll the ball to you, we will say the Bible verse together."
- Roll the ball to each child and lead her to repeat the Bible verse. Tell her to return the ball to you.
- After a few turns, open the Bible to John 3:16 and show children the words in the Bible.

PLAY WITH BABY DOLLS

Tools: Bible, 2 baby dolls, receiving blankets, a few babycare items, Story Picture: Jesus Talked to Nicodemus (Pack Item 2)

- Preschoolers enjoy playing with baby dolls and caring for them. Put the baby-care items near the dolls and prop the Story Picture in the area.
- As preschoolers begin to play out family situations and care for the dolls, ask children about babies they know. Mention that when babies are born, people are happy and joyful.
- Show children the Story Picture. Say: "When Jesus talked to Nicodemus, Jesus talked about being born."
- Open the Bible to John 3 and remark: "Jesus didn't mean that a person should become a tiny baby again. Jesus helped Nicodemus understand that when a person chooses to have faith in Jesus, the person becomes a new person in the way he acts and thinks. He is happy and joyful."

SHOW THE EMOTION

Tools: Bible, Preschool Family Card, Emotions Cards (Pack Item 23)

- Open the Bible to John 4 and lay the Family Card on the page. Spread the Emotions Cards on the floor or table in a line.
- Direct a child to look at the Emotions Cards. Say: "Let's think about today's Bible story. Some of these picture cards show emotions the woman at the well may have felt. Which pictures help you think about the story?"
- Begin to summarize the Bible story, being sure to include references to emotions such as confusion, sadness, surprise, fear, and excitement. As you talk, make facial expressions that communicate the emotions.
- Guide the preschooler to get cards that show the various emotions the woman may have felt.

BALANCE & WALK

Tools: Bible, plastic water pitcher or bowl with wide base, Activity Page

- Show a child the picture on the Activity Page. Point to the pot a woman is holding on her head. Remark: "Women in Bible times often balanced pots on their heads as they walked. Let's try to do that, too."
- Get the pitcher or bowl and place it on your head. Walk a step or two, trying to balance the pitcher as you walk. Give the preschooler a turn. After a few tries, sit down to take a break.
- Turn to John 4 in the Bible and find the story about the woman who went to a well and learned something important from Jesus. Review the Bible story as the child holds the Activity Page.

DECORATE WATER BOTTLES

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: A Woman Heard About God's Love (Pack Item 3), large adhesive printer labels, washable markers, small plastic water bottles (unopened)

- Print or write today's Bible verse on the printer labels.
 Put the labels and markers on a table with the bottles of water.
- Invite children to decorate the labels, then place them on the bottles. Suggest that the children might give their water bottles to others to tell them about God's love.
- As children decorate the labels, show the Story
 Picture and recall today's story. Remark that after
 Jesus asked the woman for a drink, He told her about
 God's love.
- Lead children to say today's Bible verse with you. Show where the verse is located in the Bible.

WORK PEOPLE PUZZLES

Tools: Bible, 2 or 3 puzzles featuring people, cloth bag

- Put puzzle frames on a table and put the puzzle pieces in the bag.
- Invite two children to work the puzzles and decide in which puzzle each piece fits. Encourage children to work together.
- While children work the puzzles, show them the Bible. Remark: "The Bible tells us about God's love. God loves every person, and He wants people to love Him. That's what a woman learned one day."
- Recall the Bible story, emphasizing that God sent Jesus to earth to show His love to all people. Say: "Jesus told the woman about God's love."

SEARCH FOR JESUS

Tools: illustrated Bible; 2 or 3 pairs of children's binoculars; pictures, books, and puzzles that have pictures of Jesus; Jesus Pictures (Music & Print Extras)

- Place the pictures and other items around the room within view of the children. Open the Bible to John 9.
- Invite a child to use binoculars to search for a picture of Jesus. When the preschooler locates a picture or other item, ask him to get it and show it to you.
- Recall the Bible story or event associated with the picture, book, or puzzle. Say: "All the stories about Jesus are true and are in the Bible for us to read."
- Say: "A story in the book of John tells about Jesus healing a man who could not see." Summarize today's Bible story.

SHINE LIGHT ON HEARTS

Tools: Bible, 2 or 3 small flashlights, large heart shape cutouts, marker, glitter glue, stickers, tape, Activity Page

- On each heart shape, write a word: *Jesus, light, love, God.* Decorate the hearts with glitter glue or stickers. Tape the hearts around the room.
- Show children the picture on the Activity Page and help children recall the Bible story about Jesus healing the man who could not see.
- Say: "Jesus showed God's love to the man. Jesus said that He is God's light for the world. Let's look around the room to find heart shapes that have words about God and Jesus."
- Give flashlights to preschoolers to shine on the heart shapes. Read the word on a shape and connect it to Jesus and the Bible story.

DRAW ON A MIRROR

Tools: Bible, nonbreakable hand mirrors, dry erase markers and erasers

- Open the Bible to John 9 and show children the place in the Bible where we read about Jesus helping the man see.
- Hand a mirror to a preschooler and comment: "You
 can see yourself in the mirror. The man in the Bible
 story did not even know what he looked like. But
 Jesus healed the man."
- Give the child a marker. Suggest he draw a picture of himself on the mirror's surface. Say: "Jesus came to help people like you and me know about God and love Him. Jesus said, 'I have come as a light.'"
- Turn to John 12:46 in the Bible and point to the words. Encourage the preschooler to say the Bible verse with you.

WALK A VERSE PATH

Tools: Bible, Footprints (Music & Print Extras), tape, marker, 2 or 3 books about Jesus

- Print and cut out enough footprints to write each word of today's Bible verse. Tape the footprints to the floor in the correct order.
- Invite a child to walk on the footprints. As he steps on the prints, read the words. At the end, say: "Those words are in the Bible. We read in the book of John that Jesus came to help people see and believe in Him. Jesus wants people to know about God's love."
- After several children have turns to walk on the verse path, sit down and review the books about Jesus.

- Draw children's attention to the Story Picture.

- After a while, move the Jesus figure as if walking to the house. Ask children to use the other figures as you recall today's Bible story.
- Say: "Martha trusted that Jesus would help her brother, and Jesus did."

MAKE A PEOPLE POSTER

Tools: Bible, long piece of white poster paper, People Picture Cutouts (Music & Print Extras), glue sticks, marker, tape

- Print one or two pages of people pictures and cut them out. Put the pictures with the paper and glue sticks on a table. Write today's Text Truth across the paper in large letters.
- Invite children to work together to make a people poster. Read the words on the poster. Say: "Our poster will remind us that everyone who believes in Jesus will live."
- As children work on the poster, listen to songs about Jesus. When the poster is finished, tape it to the wall at children's eye level.

USE A DOCTOR'S KIT

Tools: Bible, Fall Bible Markers (Pack Item 17), Preschool Family Card, toy doctor's kit, a few bandage wraps, slings, braces (opt.), baby dolls

- Preschoolers may be interested in pretending to be medical helpers. Suggest that a child be the doctor and someone else might be a nurse. Talk with preschoolers about people who help care for injured or sick people. Comment that God helps medical helpers know what to do to help sick people.
- Show the picture on the Family Card. Mention that Mary and Martha's brother was very sick, but the sisters did not call a doctor. They asked Jesus to come to their house and help Lazarus.
- Say: "Jesus told the sisters to trust Him. The sisters did, and Jesus made their brother well again."

HOP & SHOUT

Tools: Bible, Music & Print Extras, Activity Page, wide masking tape, half sheets of paper, marker

- Create a hopscotch grid using the tape. Make enough squares for each word in the Text Truth. Write each word on a paper and tape it in a square of the grid. Lay the Activity Page to the side of the grid with the Bible opened to John 11.
- First, read the words on the papers in order. Next, guide children to hop through the grid, shouting the words as they hop.
- After everyone has hopped to the end, sit down for a moment to look at the picture on the Activity Page.
 Summarize the Bible story as you hold the Bible.
- Softly play songs about Jesus as children hop and shout again.

- Ask a preschooler about times when a family member has shown love to him. Say: "John wrote in his letter that when we are kind to others, we are obeying Jesus' command. Helping and loving at home is a way to show Jesus' love."
- Show the child the picture on the Activity Page as you summarize today's Bible story.
- Open the Bible to 1 John 3:23 and point to the Bible verse. Lead the preschooler to say the verse with you.

FIND MATCHING PICTURES

Tools: Bible, Love Others Match Cards (Pack Item 26), Story Picture: A Letter About Love (Pack Item 6)

- Lay all the Match Cards facedown on a table. Mix up the cards before arranging them in rows. Put the Story Picture next to the Bible opened to 1 John.
- Show a child the Story Picture and ask the child if he can identify the man. Say: "This is John. He was one of Jesus' disciples. John loved Jesus and wrote about Him"
- Call the child's attention to the overturned cards.
 Say: "These cards have pictures that show children being kind and loving. Can you find pictures that are the same?"
- Guide the preschooler to turn over cards to find matches. As each pair is found, talk about the action that is shown. Remark that when we love others, we show our love for Jesus.

 Remark that music can help us think about Jesus and remember what He said.
- Spread the Emotions Cards on the table and talk with preschoolers about emotions they recognize. Ask children about times when they have been excited or afraid or happy.
- Play music softly. Hold the Story Picture and recall the Bible story. Comment that Jesus told John what to write in the letters to the churches.

- Cut each word card in half. Mix up the cards and place them on the floor with the book.
- Read the book to a child and tell her to look around the room for Bibles. Include classroom Bibles and teachers' Bibles. Remind the preschooler that all Bibles tell about God.
- Show the child the word card pieces and suggest that she put like colors together to form Bible words. When cards are matched, read the words and help the preschooler look for them in the Bible at Revelation 21.
- Say: "This part of the Bible tells us about a wonderful new city and world God has planned."

PLAY A BIBLE BOARD GAME

Tools: Bible, Go This Way Gameboard (Pack Item 24), Go This Way Game Cards (Pack Item 25), craft pom-poms, gift bag

- Mix the game cards and place them in the bag.
 Set the gameboard on a flat surface and invite preschoolers to play a board game.
- Lay the Bible beside the gameboard. Instruct children that each time they move to a space with an arrow, they should follow the directions on the arrow. Read the directions and assist children as needed.
- Remind children that everything written in the Bible is true. John wrote what is true about the new world God has planned. Turn to Revelation 21:3 and point to the words. Help children say the Bible verse together.

MAKE A PAPER BAG PUPPET

Tools: Bible, washable markers, paper lunch bags, yarn, glue, construction paper pieces, Activity Page, Fall Bible Markers (Pack Item 17)

- Suggest that a child use the art supplies to design a puppet. Remark that God will live with people in the new world He plans.
- As the child decides how she will make her puppet look, tell her that God made people and loves them. Say: "God loves you."
- Ask the child to tell you about her puppet.
- Show the picture on the Activity Page as you review the Bible story.
- Open the Bible to today's marker at Revelation 21:3. Read the verse to the child and invite her to repeat it with you.

MOVE & SAY

Tools: Bible, index cards, marker

- Write action words on cards: *sway, wiggle, jump, clap*. Put the cards next to the Bible.
- Say today's Bible verse "God has shown His faithful love to me." Ask preschoolers to repeat the verse.
- Direct a child to choose an action card. Read the action and tell the child to do the action while saying the Bible verse.
- After several children move and say the verse, sit down and show children the verse in the Bible. Say: "These words are true for us, too. God shows His love to us just as He did to the people in today's Bible story." Recall what Moses told God's people.

MAKE A HEART HANGER

Tools: Bibles, Activity Page, small white paper plates, different designs of heart stickers, marker, hole punch, red yarn or ribbon

- Write today's Bible verse on the paper plates. Punch a hole in each plate.
- Give a child a plate to decorate. Say: "You may make a heart hanger to put on the door at home. Choose the heart stickers you want to put on your plate."
- Read the words to the child. Say: "God loves us and cares for us. This hanger can help you remember that."
- After the child finishes his work, tie a ribbon or piece of yarn through the hole in the plate to make a hanger.
- Show the Activity Page as you recall the Bible story.

CARE FOR DOLLS

Tools: Bible, 2 or more baby dolls, toy bottles, spoons, bibs, blankets, child's rocker, several books about God

- Invite children to use the items to care for the baby dolls. Say that the children's families care for them.
- Open the Bible to Deuteronomy 1 and say: "Families traveled to the land of Canaan together. God took care of the families on the long journey and gave them everything they needed. Moses reminded the people that God was with them all the time because He loved them."
- As children continue to play, read books about God.
 Lead children to tell ways God shows His love to them and their families.

MOVE SAND IN A PAN

Tools: Bible, baking pan with 1-inch sides, clean play sand or cornmeal, Allergy Sign (Music & Print Extras), Story Picture: God Cared for His People (Pack Item 10), towel

- Lay the Story Picture in the pan. Pour a thin layer of sand or cornmeal over the picture to cover it. Place the pan on the towel.
- Open the Bible to the book of Deuteronomy.
- Invite a child to move her fingers through the sand. What does the child see? As she pushes away the sand, the Story Picture will be revealed.
- Say: "That is a picture of Moses talking to God's people. Moses was the leader of the people. Moses told the people everything God had done for them on the long journey."
- While the child continues to move sand in the pan, recall today's Bible story and the things God did to help the people and show His love.

Tools: Bible, paper, markers, crayons, stickers, Preschool Family Card

- Show the Family Card to a child and say: "Moses told God's people to obey God's laws." Review some of God's laws such as love God, honor your parents, and do what is right.
- Invite the child to decorate a paper with the word *Obey* printed on it. Give the child the art supplies to use as she wishes. Suggest that she might draw pictures of herself following one of God's laws.
- Invite the child to tell you about her word page and drawings.
- Summarize today's story, noting that God's laws are helpful. Help the preschooler say today's Bible verse with you.

PLAY MUSICAL CHAIRS

Tools: Bible, Music & Print Extras, paper, markers, tape

- On half sheets of paper, write words associated with today's Bible story. Words might include: obey, love, do good, teach the children, laws, worship. Tape the papers to chairs arranged in a circle (seats facing outward).
- Play music and direct preschoolers to walk around the circle of chairs. Stop the music and tell children to be seated. Call on one child whose chair has a word paper.
- Read the word and associate it with today's Bible story or Text Truth.
- Resume music and walking until all the words have been reviewed.

WORK A WORD PUZZLE

Tools: Bible, Fall Bible Markers (Pack Item 17), heavyweight paper, marker, scissors, Activity Page

- Write the Bible verse on the paper. Cut the paper into four pieces. Place the pieces at random places in the Bible. Put today's verse marker at Deuteronomy 6:17.
- Guide a preschooler to look through the Bible to find the paper pieces.
- Say: "These are words of today's Bible verse. Let's put the words in order."
- Help the child arrange the puzzle pieces to form the Bible verse.
 - Then suggest he turn to the marker in the Bible and compare the words. Help younger preschoolers recognize letters and words.
- Read the verse, then look at the Activity Page to review the Bible story.

LACE CARDS

Tools: Bible, God's Laws Lacing Cards (Pack Item 32), hole punch, Story Picture: Laws for God's People (Pack Item 11), yarn

- Punch holes around the Story Picture and tie a long piece of yarn to one hole. Add the Story Picture lacing card to the other cards and put them with the Bible.
- Invite a preschooler to choose a card to lace. Guide her to weave the yarn in and out of the holes.
- While the child is busy, talk about the pictures on the cards, relating them to today's Bible story or God's commands. Say: "Moses told the people they should love and worship God and obey all the commands He gave them." Review the Bible story in your words.

Tools: Bible, Activity Page, Music & Print Extras, large plastic hoop, large playground ball

- Lay the hoop on the floor and lay the Activity Page in the center. Invite two or three children to stand around the hoop.
- Say: "Let's play a game about ways to praise God. I will play music while you pass the ball. When I stop the music, the child holding the ball may bounce it on the picture and name a way to praise God."
- Play several rounds to give children an opportunity to bounce the ball and speak. Suggested ways to praise God include singing or making music, praying, giving, and reading the Bible.

ARRANGE WORD PLATES

Tools: Bible marked at Psalm 100:4b, Fall Bible Markers, 9 solid-colored paper plates, black marker

- Use the marker to write one word of today's Bible verse on each paper plate. Write the Scripture reference on a plate, too. Stack the plates next to the Bible.
- Touch the paper plates to get a child's attention. Say: "These are pretty party plates, aren't they? I've written some words on the plates that come from the Bible. The words are today's Bible verse. Let's put the word plates in order and say the verse together."
- Direct the child to open the Bible to the marker. Read the Bible verse and say the first word again. Guide the child to find the word written on a paper plate. Help nonreaders find the words as you say them slowly.
- After sequencing the verse, lead the child to repeat the Bible verse.

BALANCE & CARRY BASKETS

Tools: Bible; Story Picture: Festivals to Praise God (Pack Item 12); several large wicker baskets, some with handles; shredded paper or crepe paper strips (opt.); masking tape

- Make a short tape path across the room. Put the items on the floor and prop the Story Picture against a basket. When preschoolers show interest, suggest that they look at the Story Picture to see baskets.
- Remark that the people gathered grain and other items for the special festivals. The people took offerings to show God that they loved Him.
- Suggest that a child choose a basket to balance on his head as he walks on the path. Another child might gather grain (paper strips) to put in a basket to carry as he walks on the path.
- When children reach the end, summarize the Bible story.

MAKE A SHAKER

Tools: Bible, small plastic bottles with caps, pebbles or shiny beads, spoon, decorative tape, permanent marker (for teacher)

- Invite a child to make a musical shaker. Guide the child to spoon a few pebbles into the bottle. Fasten the cap securely and tape around it.
- Offer strips of colored tape for the preschooler to decorate her bottle. Write the Text Truth around the bottle.
- Lead the child to shake a steady beat as you chant the Bible verse. Encourage the preschooler to say the words with you.
- Say: "The Bible says to give thanks to God and bless His name."

- Offer a variety of puzzle-type activities for preschoolers to enjoy today. Encourage preschoolers to exchange puzzles once in a while.
- While children play the board game or work picture puzzles, play music in the background. Listen for songs about God. Sing along or hum to the music.
- Show the Story Picture to the puzzle workers. Ask a child to tell you what he remembers about the story or the people in the picture. Help with answers.
- Open the Bible to Deuteronomy 31 and say: "No matter where we are or what we do, God is with us. He will never leave us. We can be brave and strong."





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
Story Picture Page 2: Jesus Talked to Nicodemus




Story Picture Page 5: Jesus Healed Lazarus
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
