## **₹**\* CIRCLE TIME

### **GATHER**

- Place the bowl, pitcher, and towel in the box and close it.
- Play music as toddlers walk to the circle. Hold the box in your lap.
- Show children the items and remark that the items help you think about a Bible story.
- Set the box on the floor and show the Story Picture (Pack Item 1).

### **HEAR THE BIBLE STORY**

- Open the Bible to John 13 and tell the story in your words.
- After the story, ask questions:
  Who ate a special meal together?
  (Jesus and His helpers)
  What did Jesus do after eating?
  (He washed His helpers' feet.)
  Who did not want Jesus to wash his feet? (Peter)
  What did Jesus say? (He must wash Peter's feet to show Peter how to serve others in love.)

### PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Open the Bible to today's Verse Marker at Galatians 5:13 and point to the verse.
- Say the verse, close the Bible, then hand the Bible to the child sitting next to you.
- Tell the child to open the Bible to the marker. Help the child say the verse, close the Bible, and pass the Bible to the next child.
- Give every toddler a turn to say the verse.

### PRAY

 Say a short prayer thanking God that Jesus showed us how to serve others and be kind and loving.



## SERVE A SNACK TO FRIENDS

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus Washed His Friends' Feet (Pack Item 1), crackers, napkins, cups, pitcher of water, Allergy Sign (Music & Print Extras)

- Invite children to sit at the table. Ask one child to give a napkin to each person.
   Assist another child in placing a few crackers on each friend's napkin. Serve each child a small cup of water.
- While children enjoy a snack together, show the Story Picture and recall the meal Jesus ate with His friends.
- Open the Bible to John 13 and say: "Jesus wants us to show love and kindness. Jesus wants us to serve others."

### MATCH PICTURES & WORK PUZZLES

Tools: Bible, Bible Match (Pack Item 23), Jesus Puzzles (Pack Item 24), basket

- Place the Bible Match cards in the basket and set the basket with the Bible.
- Show a toddler the Bible on the table and turn a few pages. Say: "This Bible looks different from the one I have. But all Bibles tell about Jesus."
- Tell the child the basket has pictures of different Bibles. Invite the toddler to find pictures that match.
- Give the Jesus Puzzles to other children nearby and encourage them to put the pieces together. Say: "We learn about Jesus from the Bible."

### MOVE TO TAPE SHAPES

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, Book: What Does Jesus Want Me to Do? (Pack Item 19), colored tape

- Use the tape to create a variety of large shapes on the floor. Place the Diaper Bag Card in a shape and the book in a shape.
- Guide toddlers to crawl to a square, hop to a triangle, tiptoe to a circle, or jump to a line. Say: "Move to the circle." Or, "Move to the triangle" and so on.
- When children move to the shape with the Diaper Bag Card, look at the picture and recall that Jesus showed His helpers what to do to show love.
- When children move to the shape with the book, sit down and read it together.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

### **GATHER**

- Play the song "Who Was Jesus" (Music & Print Extras, track 2) and begin walking around the room. Wave a streamer.
- Give children streamers to wave.
- Lead the children to the circle.
   Continue waving streamers and singing to the music.
- When all children are seated, collect the streamers and hand each child a Bible with a ribbon marking John 15.

### HEAR THE BIBLE STORY

- Tell children to place the Bible in their laps or on the floor.
- Lay the Story Picture (Pack Item
   2) on the floor in the center of the circle. Distribute the Jesus' Face
   Pictures (Pack Item 18).
- Say: "Each time you hear me say Jesus' name, hold up your picture."

• Open your Bible to John 15 and tell the story in your own words.

### PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- With the Bible in your lap, show the children how to open their Bibles to the ribbons marking John 15.
- Say: "This is where we read about Jesus teaching His disciples about vines and fruit. John wrote about this so that more people could learn from Jesus."
- Help toddlers find verse 5 and touch the words with their fingers.
- Lead children to say the Bible verse together.

### PRAY

- Say a brief prayer, thanking Jesus for helping us grow to be like him.
- Ask God to help each of us do the things that are pleasing to Him and honor Him.



## CREATE A VINE PICTURE

Tools: Bible, heavyweight copy paper, marker, green paper, glue sticks, Grapes & Vines Pictures (Music & Print Extras)

- Write the statement Jesus is the vine, and God is the gardener across the bottom of a paper. Draw a curvy line across the paper or from top to bottom.
- Show a child how to tear the green paper into small pieces, then glue the green pieces on the line to create a vine.
- Read the statement on the child's paper.
   Say: "Jesus helps us grow to be more like Him."
- Show the child the pictures of grapes and vines as you recall today's Bible story.

### **REVEAL THE STORY PICTURE**

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus Talked About Vines and Fruit (Pack Item 2), pad of sticky notes, Music & Print Extras

- Cover the entire Story Picture with the sticky notes.
- Invite children to remove sticky notes one at a time and tell something about the picture.
- As more of the picture is revealed, recall the Bible story.
- Open the Bible to John 15. Say: "John wrote about Jesus."
- Play music and sing along to songs about Jesus.

### PASS THE FRUIT

Tools: Bible, Music & Print Extras, plastic grapes or other toy fruit

- Play music and move the fruit back and forth in your hands. As toddlers observe what you are doing, invite them to play a game.
- Tell children to form a circle. Say: "Pass the fruit around the circle. When I stop the music, I will give an instruction to the person holding the fruit."
- Play and pause the music. Give every child a turn to follow an instruction: Tap your head and say, "Be like Jesus." Blink your eyes and clap your hands. Wiggle your fingers and say, "Jesus talked about vines and fruit." Step in place and repeat the Bible verse.
- After a while, tell the children: "Jesus wants us to follow His instructions and be more like Him."

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

- Signal toddlers to join you for Circle Time.
- As you walk to the Circle Time area, sing and clap these words to the tune "BINGO":

  I know that Jesus loves me.

  B-I-B-L-E, B-I-B-L-E, B-I-B-L-E,

  I can read the Bible.
- Invite children to sing along.

**HEAR THE BIBLE STORY** 

- Hold the Story Picture (Pack Item
  3) for the children to see.
- Ask a child to come to you and point to Jesus in the picture.
- Thank the child, then ask toddlers to describe what Jesus is doing.
- After children respond, comment: "Yes, Jesus went to a garden after He prayed at the supper. Listen to a story about Jesus."

• Open the Bible to John 17 and tell the Bible story.

### PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Show children today's Verse Marker (Pack Item 15) and read it.
- Describe a child (clothing, hair, shoes, eye color, so on) and tell that child to stand. Lead the toddler to say the Bible verse, then sit down.
- Continue giving other children turns to stand and say the verse.
- Remark that John, one of Jesus' disciples, wrote about Jesus' prayer.

### PRAY

- Pray briefly and ask God to help children be ready to tell others about Jesus.
- Thank God for hearing us pray to Him.



## LACE A PICTURE CARD

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, hole punch, long shoelace, shape sorter toy

- Punch holes around the Diaper Bag Card and tie the shoelace through a hole and knot it.
- Place the lacing card with the shape sorter toy. Open the Bible to John 17.
- Invite a toddler to lace the picture card or put shapes in the sorter. While the child is busy, read the Text Truth printed on the card.
- Remark: "Jesus prayed. After talking with His disciples, Jesus and the men walked to a garden."

### LISTEN TO MUSIC & DRAW

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus' Prayer (Pack Item 3), Music & Print Extras, large sheet of white paper, tape, marker, crayons

- Tape the paper on a table. Write today's Bible verse across the center of the paper.
- Place the crayons on the paper and invite a few children to draw. Play music softly in the background.
- As children draw, read the words on the paper. Say: "Jesus prayed for God's help. We can ask God to help us, too."
- Show the Story Picture as you recall the Bible story. Turn to John 17 and show children the story passage.
- Sing along to songs about Jesus.

### SPELL WITH LETTER BLOCKS

Tools: Bible, cardboard blocks, 4 colored cards, marker, strip of paper, tape

- On the strip of paper, write the word *Pray*. Write on each card one letter of the word *Pray*. Tape the cards to blocks.
- Invite toddlers to build and stack. When children notice the letter cards on some blocks, name the letters. Lead children to say the letters.
- Lay aside the letter blocks and tell children the letters spell an important word. Show children the word on the paper strip.
- Say: "This word is *Pray*. Jesus prayed. Let's put the letters in order to spell the word *Pray*."
- After children spell the word, recall the Bible story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

Tools: Bible, blocks, toy horse, toy people figures, Diaper Bag Card

- Show a child the picture on the Diaper Bag Card. Point to the road and people.
- Lead the child to use blocks to make a road. Line up people beside the road.
- Suggest that the toddler "walk" the horse on the road. Say: "Jesus rode a donkey on the road to the city."
- Encourage the child to play with the people figures, pretending they are waving and shouting to Jesus. Lead the child to say "Hosanna to Jesus!"
- Help the child say today's Bible verse.

### DRAW ON ROBE CUTOUTS

Tools: Bible, copy paper cut in robe shapes, crayons, Story Picture: People Welcomed Jesus (Pack Item 4)

- $\bullet$  Lay robe cutouts and crayons on a table.
- Show children the Story Picture and note the robes people are wearing and the robes that are on the road. Remark: "The people were happy to see Jesus. They used their robes to cover the path as Jesus rode into the city."
- While children draw on their robe cutouts, say: "The people loved Jesus and shouted praises to Him."
- When children finish drawing, write today's Bible verse on the back of the robe cutouts.

### MAKE PLAY DOUGH TRACKS

Tools: Bible, toy people figures or miniature dolls with feet, foot-shaped cookie cutters, toy horse, fresh play dough, rolling pins

- Give a small amount of dough to a child. Suggest that he roll out dough and press the feet of the toy people, horse's hooves, or the cookie cutters in the dough.
- Talk about the tracks made in the dough. Open the Bible to John 12 and say: "Jesus and His friends went to Jerusalem.
   Jesus rode a donkey on the road. The donkey and the people following Jesus probably made tracks on the dusty road."
- Mention that people walked many places to see and hear Jesus.
   The people loved Jesus, and He loved them.
- Open the Bible to John 12 as you summarize the Bible story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

## **☆ CIRCLE TIME**

### **GATHER**

- Lay plastic hoops on the floor. Call toddlers to play a game.
- Say: "I will say 'In,' and you will move into the hoops. When I say 'Out,' you should step out of the hoops."
- Lead toddlers to step in and out of the hoops several times, then walk around the hoops.
- Finally, tell children to find a place to sit down.
- Say: "Today is a special day to think about Jesus. Listen to a story about a friend who was sad that Jesus was gone."

### Ask preschoolers: "Why were Jesus' friends sad?" Help children remember that Jesus was gone and no longer with His friends.

### PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Hold the Bible open to the book of John. Ask toddlers if they remember who wrote today's story about Jesus.
- Say: "John wrote this story. John knew Jesus and loved Him."
- Turn to Hebrews 12:2. Say:
  "Someone else wrote about Jesus.
  This person wrote, 'Jesus got on the cross.' Let's say those words."
- Lead the group to say today's Bible verse and Scripture reference.

### **HEAR THE BIBLE STORY**

- Show the Story Picture (Pack Item 5), then lay it in the center of the hoops.
- Open the Bible to John 18 and tell the Bible story.

### PRAY

- Say: "Easter is a time when we remember Jesus and what He did for us. Let's thank God for Jesus."
- Pray: "Thank You, God, for sending Your Son to help people."

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## PLAY WITH POP BEADS

Tools: Bible, Jesus Story Pictures (Music & Print Extras), plastic dishpan, pop beads

- Lay the picture cutouts and the Bible in the dishpan, then cover them with pop beads.
- Invite a toddler to play with pop beads.
   Suggest he snap them together or sort them by colors or shapes.
- While the child digs in the pan, he will discover the Bible and pictures. As he pulls out a picture, talk about the picture.
- Ask the child to take out the Bible. Help the child open the Bible to John 18.
   Summarize the story for the child.

### SEARCH BIBLES FOR PICTURES OF JESUS

Tools: several different children's Bibles, 8-inch pieces of wide ribbon

- Give a child several ribbon pieces.
   Encourage the toddler to turn Bible pages carefully to search for pictures of Jesus. Say: "Mark the pages with ribbons."
- Toddlers may mark pictures of other Bible persons. That is OK. Simply say that the Bible tells about Jesus and many other people.
- Show a child a picture in a Bible. Comment on the event represented by the picture.
- Say: "The Bible tells about Jesus and the things He did while He lived on earth."

### PLAY WITH PEOPLE FIGURES

Tools: Bible, cardboard blocks, toy people figures, Story Picture: The First Easter (Pack Item 5), Jesus Puzzles (Pack Item 24)

- Invite toddlers to stack blocks and move the people figures. Suggest that toddlers build a house for the figures or pretend the people are going to church to learn about Jesus.
- While children play, show them the Story Picture. Say: "Mary Magdalene was sad after Jesus died on the cross and was no longer with His friends. Mary Magdalene went to the garden to see where people took Jesus. Mary Magdalene saw something strange."
- Point to Mary Magdalene in the picture and recall that she and her friends were sad that Jesus was gone. Invite children to work the Jesus Puzzles.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

- Stop the music and tell the child holding the Bible to open it to the marked page. Tell the child to say "Jesus is alive."

## DISCOVER WHAT'S UNDER

Tools: Bible, Book: J-E-S-U-S (Pack Item 21), Preschool Family Card, card with the words Jesus Is Alive! written on it, white towel, beanbag

- Spread the items on the floor and cover them with the towel.
- Invite toddlers to sit with you. Call attention to the towel. Say: "Under this towel are some things that help us learn about Jesus. Each of you may have a turn to toss a beanbag on the towel, then peek to discover what's under the towel."
- After everyone has a turn, show all the items. Tell the way each item relates to the good news that Jesus is alive.

### MAKE A "JESUS IS ALIVE" CARD

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, "Jesus Is Alive" Notes (Music & Print Extras), markers, crayons, star and happy face stickers

- Provide a "Jesus Is Alive" Note for each toddler to make a card. Write the Bible verse on the back of the cards.
- Encourage toddlers to decorate the cards to give to friends or family members.
  Write the recipient's name on the front of a note.
- As children work on their cards, show the picture on the Diaper Bag Card.
- Say: "When Mary Magdalene went to the tomb, she discovered that Jesus was alive. It was wonderful news!"

### **CRINKLE & STUFF PAPER**

Tools: Bible, colorful tissue paper, plastic clothes basket with open spaces, Story Picture: A Surprise for Jesus' Friends (Pack Item 6)

- Turn the basket upside down. Lay the Bible on top and scatter the paper around the basket.
- Guide a toddler to stuff pieces of paper through the holes of the basket. After filling in several spaces, suggest that the child pause for a moment to look at a picture with you.
- Show the Story Picture to the child. Ask the child to name the people in the picture. Give help if needed.

- Describe a fish's colors and patterns. Call on a child with a raised hand to get the fish card.

## TASTE BREAD

- Post the Allergy Sign where families will see it before the session.
- Serve each child a small piece of bread on a napkin and some water.

- Cover the card again for another child to have a turn to move sand.

### MAKE A BIBLE BOOKMARK

Tools: Bible, poster board strips, washable markers, fish stickers

- Suggest a child use fish stickers and markers to decorate a bookmark. Write today's Bible verse on one side of the child's strip of paper.
- Comment: "These words are in the Bible. John wrote about the time when Jesus told His helpers to follow Him."
- Encourage the child to decorate his bookmark however he wishes. Then he may take it home to put in a Bible.
- Use the tune "Mary Had a Little Lamb" to sing: Jesus said to follow Him, follow Him. Jesus said to follow Him. We will follow Him.
- While the child works, summarize today's Bible story.

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

- Turn to Acts 13 and show the page. Point to the name of the book and say: "This is the book of Acts."

### PRACTICE BIBLE SKILLS

- Turn to Matthew 28:19. Read the verse and close the Bible.
- Hand the Bible to a child and ask him to stand and hold up the Bible. Encourage the group to repeat the Bible verse together.
- Give every toddler a turn to hold the Bible and say the Bible verse.

### PRAY

- Ask children to name people who teach them about Jesus.
   Suggestions might include parents, grandparents, teachers, the pastor, friends.
- Say a prayer thanking God for those who teach people about Jesus.

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# SEE, HEAR, & SAY BIBLE VERSE WORDS

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 15), 5 large cards, marker, Story Picture: Paul's First Journey (Pack Item 8)

- On each card, write one word of the Bible verse. Write the Scripture reference on a card. Put today's Verse Marker in the Bible at Matthew 28:19.
- Show a child the Story Picture as you recall that Paul and Barnabas did God's work. Say: "We can do God's work, too."

- Lead children to say the Bible verse aloud.

### **DECORATE A BIBLE NAME**

Tools: Bible, ribbon to mark Acts 13, copy paper, crayons or washable markers, Preschool Family Card

- Print the name *Paul* in large letters on a sheet of paper for each child.
- Give a child a paper and crayons or markers. Say: "Your paper has the name of a Bible person written on it. *Paul*. The Bible tells about Paul."
- Suggest that the preschooler decorate his paper while you recall today's Bible story about Paul. Show the picture on the Family Card.
- After a while, help the child turn to Acts 13 and look for Paul's name.

### **CLEAN THE ROOM**

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, clean cloths, plastic spray bottle, water, toy broom and mop

- Open the Bible to Acts 13 and lay a book on the Bible.
- Invite toddlers to clean the room using the toy broom, mop, and cloths. Children can clean tables and other surfaces by spraying them lightly with water and wiping them dry.
- Encourage toddlers to take turns using the cleaning items.
   Comment that this is a way for them to work together.
- Touch the Bible and say: "Paul worked with other men to teach people about Jesus." Show the picture on the Diaper Bag Card. Point to Paul and Barnabas walking through a city and talking to people. Summarize the Bible story.

- Thank God for church people who work together to tell about Jesus.
- Ask God to help teachers, families, friends, and church leaders work together to share the good news of Jesus.



## MATCH WORKER PICTURES

Tools: Bible, Worker Pictures (Music & Print Extras), scissors, Story Picture: Paul's Second Journey (Pack Item 9)

- Print two sets of the Worker Pictures so you have duplicate pictures of each worker. Choose three or four pairs of pictures.
- Spread the pictures facedown on a table. Open the Bible to 1 Corinthians 3:9 and lay the Story Picture on the Bible.
- Tell a child that pictures on the table show people who are workers. Encourage the child to look for matching pictures.
- Say: "People work together to help and serve others. Paul and Barnabas worked together. You and I can work together."

### **SCOOP & MOVE BALLS**

Tools: Bible, Jesus' Face Pictures (Pack Item 18), 6-cup muffin pan, 3 table tennis balls, plastic tongs or large scooped spoon

- Place three or four pictures of Jesus in the bottom of the muffin pan cups and place balls on top of the pictures.
- Guide a toddler to use the tongs to move the balls to empty cups. Each time a ball is removed, comment about the picture of Jesus.
- Remark that Paul loved Jesus and worked with other people to tell everyone the good news.
- Chant: "Tell about Jesus, tell about Jesus, we can tell people about Jesus."

### TRAVEL THROUGH AN OBSTACLE COURSE

Tools: 2 or 3 Bibles, painter's tape, various objects from around the room, Diaper Bag Card

- Set up an obstacle course. Use the painter's tape to go over and around different objects.
- Guide a child to carry a Bible as he travels through the obstacle course. Suggest that the child stop at points (objects) along the way. At each stop, tell him something from the Bible story.
- When the child completes the course, help him open the Bible to Acts 15. Comment that in this chapter of Acts, we learn about Paul traveling with Silas to tell people in other places the good news about Jesus. Show the picture on the Diaper Bag Card.
- Say: "Paul and Silas were God's workers. We can be workers, too."

- Make a final diaper check.
- Put a Diaper Bag Card and Preschool Family Card in each child's bag.
- Release children to authorized adults.

## WALK TO THE WALL

Tools: Bible, Diaper Bag Card, Footprints (Music & Print Extras), tape

Tools: Bible, 4 colored plastic drink cups, 4 plastic blocks in same colors as cups, 4 cards in same colors as cups, marker, tape

- On each card, write one word of the Bible verse. Write the reference on a card. Tape the cards to a table. Write words of the Bible verse and reference on the cups.
- Show a child the cards and read the words. Say: "Paul told the guard to believe in Jesus."

- Put today's Verse Marker in the Bible at John 15:5. Arrange the books on the cloth spread on the floor.
- As children join you and peruse the books, mention that the books remind you of today's Bible story.
- Recall that Jesus talked about fruit and vines. Jesus said that good vines make good fruit.
- Invite children to choose books to read.

#### PLAY "WHAT'S MISSING?"

Tools: Bible; tray; towel; small items from the room (paintbrush, plastic fruit, wooden block, toy garden tool, paper leaf cutout)

- Place the items on the tray and show them to the children. Cover the items with the towel.
- Direct children to look up while you take away an item.
- Ask preschoolers to help each other identify what is missing from the tray. When the item is named, ask the group how the item can help them think about the Bible story about vines and fruit. Give hints as needed.
- Return the item to the tray and play again.
- Thank preschoolers for helping each other name the items and tell how they helped children learn more about Jesus.

- Distribute a few Bibles and ask teachers to help children locate John 17.

#### PRAY

• Pray briefly for the children and families at church today.

#### **WRAP UP**

• Form groups of two or three preschoolers and a teacher. Look at the Activity Page, review the Bible story, and say the Bible verse.



#### WRITE ON DRY ERASE BOARDS

Tools: Bible, Activity Page, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), small dry erase boards, dry erase markers or crayons, erasers

- Lay the Activity Page near the boards and markers. Open the Bible to John 17:1 and insert today's Verse Marker.
- Encourage preschoolers to write or draw something they know about Jesus. Suggest that you have learned that Jesus loved people and prayed for them.

Tools: Bible, paper, dark marker, half sheets of fine-grained sandpaper, yarn cut into 3- or 4-inch pieces, Preschool Family Card

- Use the marker to write on the paper the words *Jesus* and *Pray*. Lay the paper with the Bible opened to John 17:1.
- Give a child a sandpaper sheet and several yarn pieces.
   Point to the paper and read the words. Spell the letters in each word.
- Suggest that a child choose a word to shape on her sandpaper. (If necessary, lightly write the letters on the sandpaper for her.) Guide the child to lay the yarn pieces on the sandpaper to spell the words.
- Relate each word to today's Bible story. Show the picture on the Family Card as you recall that Jesus prayed.

#### **WALK & WATCH**

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Jesus' Prayer (Pack Item 3)

- Take a few children at a time on a walk through the church building. Tell children: "Let's walk to see what people at our church are doing. Look and listen for people praying, singing, or reading the Bible."
- Show children the Story Picture and remark that after He
  explained many things to the disciples, Jesus prayed. He
  asked God to help Him do what God planned for Him to
  do. Jesus also prayed for other people. After the prayer,
  Jesus and the disciples walked to a garden.
- Return to the room. Recall the things children saw people at your church doing.

- Use the hole punch to make holes around the Story Picture. Cut a long ribbon and tie it through one hole and knot it.
- Show a child the Story Picture and ask the child to describe the picture. Help the preschooler recall the events of the Bible story.
- Invite the child to lace the ribbon around the picture. Play music while the child works, singing along with songs about Jesus.

#### PLACE POM-POMS ON A LETTER

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), wide masking tape, small colored craft pom-poms, plastic bowl

- Put today's marker in the Bible at John 12:13.
- Use the tape to make a large letter J on the floor. Put the bowl of pom-poms next to the letter.
- When a child shows interest, help him identify the letter.
   Say: "Yes, that is the letter *J*, and it is the first letter in the name *Jesus*. Can you lay pom-poms on the tape to make the letter?"
- Open the Bible to the marker and find the name Jesus on the Bible page. Remark: "People shouted words of praise to Jesus."

#### **DRIVE TOY CARS & TRUCKS**

Tools: Bible, Activity Page, wooden blocks, several toy cars and trucks

- Lay the Activity Page with the blocks and vehicles. Open the Bible to John 12.
- As children play with the vehicles, ask them how they came to church.
- Say: "We ride in cars and trucks. Some people ride bicycles and motorcycles. Some hop on buses or trains.
   Jesus rode to Jerusalem on a donkey. The people showed their love for Jesus by spreading palm branches and coats on the road. Jesus rode the donkey over the decorated path."
- Show the picture on the Activity Page and lead children to find Jesus, the donkey, happy people, palm branches, and robes.

#### **PLAY WITH ANIMALS & BLOCKS**

Tools: Bible, plastic interlocking blocks, toy farm animals

- Suggest that children build pens for the animals. Talk with children as they play, being mindful to direct the conversation to the Bible story.
- Show children the Bible and comment that the Bible is the story of Jesus. Turn to John 12 and recall that John wrote about Jesus riding a donkey to Jerusalem.
- Say: "Jesus told His disciples to go to the village and untie a donkey and bring it to Him."
- Use the tune "Are You Sleeping?" to sing these words with children: People shouted, people shouted, Ho-san-na, Ho-san-na. Hosanna to Je-sus, Hosanna to Je-sus. We love You. We love You.

#### ARRANGE FLOWERS

Tools: Bible, fresh or artificial flowers, nonbreakable vase, colander with large drain holes, Activity Page, Allergy Sign (Music & Print Extras)

- Turn the colander upside down. Insert a few flower stems in the drain holes. Arrange some flowers in the vase.
- Invite a preschooler to arrange flowers. As the child works, say: "Plants and flowers often grow in gardens. Jesus' body was taken to a garden. Mary Magdalene went to the garden. She was surprised when she arrived."
- Show the picture on the Activity Page. Recall the reason Mary Magdalene was surprised. Summarize the Bible story.

#### **WALK ON FOOTPRINTS**

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: The First Easter (Pack Item 5), Footprints (Music & Print Extras), colored paper, scissors, tape, Music & Print Extras

- Print footprints on colored paper and cut them out. Make enough footprints to tape a path on the floor. Put the Story Picture and Bible at the end of the path.
- Play music and invite children to walk on the footprints to reach the Bible. Show children the Story Picture, remarking that Mary Magdalene walked on a path to the garden tomb.
- Comment: "After discovering that Jesus' body was not in the tomb, Mary Magdalene hurried to tell Jesus' disciples the news."
- Recall the Bible story as children walk the footprint path again.

#### **DECORATE CROSSES**

Tools: Bible, wide craft sticks, colored electrical tape, simple stickers, crayons

- Make craft stick crosses ahead of time. Lay one stick across another. Use narrow strips of electrical tape to fasten the sticks together.
- Spread the pre-made crosses on the table with the stickers and crayons. Lay a cross on the Bible opened to Hebrews 12:2.
- Show children the supplies and invite boys and girls to decorate the crosses however they wish.
- As children decorate their crosses, touch the Bible and read today's Bible verse: Jesus endured the cross. Hebrews 12:2. Comment: "Jesus suffered and died on the cross. He did that because He loves people and wants to help them. At Easter, we remember what Jesus did for us, and we celebrate Him."

#### PLAY MUSICAL CHAIRS

Tools: Bible, Spring Text Truths (Pack Item 18), Music & Print Extras, chairs (1 per child)

- Arrange the chairs in a circle with seats facing out. Lay
  the Bible in one chair. Slip today's Text Truth strip in the
  Bible at John 18.
- Play music and invite children to walk around the chairs. Stop the music.
- Tell the child who sits in the chair with the Bible to stand. Say: "Please open the Bible to the marker. At this place in the Bible, we read that Jesus died on the cross."

   Place the Notes and art supplies on a table with the Bible opened to Mark 16:6.
- Give a child a note paper and read the good news words.
   Invite the child to decorate the paper however he wishes.
- Give the child an envelope. Invite him to decorate the envelope if he chooses. Then ask the preschooler to whom he wants to give his good news note. Write the person's name on the envelope, then help the child fold the Note in half to slip into the envelope.

- Cut out a variety of stone shapes from the vinyl. On three shapes, write individual words of the Text Truth.

- Invite preschoolers to walk on the "stones." When a child gets to a word, say it aloud. At the end of the stone path, sit down and look at the picture on the Activity Page.

#### **WRAP UP**

• Form groups of two or three preschoolers and a teacher. Look at the Activity Page, review the Bible story, and say the Bible verse.



#### PASS THE PICTURE

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Paul's First Journey (Pack Item 8), beanbag

- Sit on the floor and invite several children to sit in a circle with you. Pass the Story Picture around the circle for the children to see.
- After one pass, lay the picture in the center of the circle. Toss the beanbag to a child. Ask: "What is your favorite part of this Bible story?" Or, "Can you tell something you remember about this story?"
- After the child responds, pass the picture again. Stop to give another child a turn to answer a question. Repeat until everyone has had a turn.

#### **DECORATE BIBLE WORDS**

Tools: Bible, Book: Paul Loved Jesus (Pack Item 29), ACTS Key Words (Music & Print Extras), small circle dot stickers, washable markers, Bible Book Cards (Pack Item 17)

- Print the ACTS Key Words and cut the pages in half. Put the pages on a table with the dot stickers and markers.
   Lay the book with the Bible.
- Read the Key Words to a child and remark that all of them help us think about Paul. Say: "We read about Paul in the Bible. The book of Acts helps us know that Paul loved Jesus and wanted to tell everyone about Him."
   Show the child the Acts Bible Book Card.
- Ask the child to choose a word to decorate while you picture-read the book about Paul.

#### **ROLL CARS ON A MAP**

Tools: Bible, several toy vehicles, a large printed map of your city or state, Activity Page, New Testament Map (Pack Item 27)

- Lay the maps and cars on the floor. As children begin to play with the cars, talk about maps being a guide to help people know where to go.
- Say: "Some people use a GPS to guide them. Perhaps your family uses a map or GPS when you travel."
- While children tell about their trips or experiences going places, comment that Paul traveled to many places to do God's work. Point to a few key cities on the New Testament Map.
- Say: "God directed Paul and told him where to go. Paul told people about God's Son, Jesus, and helped people know how to live like Jesus."
- Show children the picture on the Activity Page and recall the Bible story.

#### **MOVE POM-POMS**

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), box lid, small muffin pan, colored craft pom-poms, plastic tongs

- Lay today's Bible Verse Marker in the box lid and cover it with pom-poms. Open the Bible to Matthew 28:19.
- Squeeze tongs to pick up a pom-pom and move it from the box lid to the muffin pan. Encourage a preschooler to do the same until he fills the cups of the muffin pan.
- When the Verse Marker is revealed, read the verse to the child. Touch the open Bible page and say: "Jesus told His disciples to go everywhere and teach the people about Him and God. That is what Paul did. Jesus chose Paul to do God's work."

#### PLAY HOPSCOTCH

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), masking tape, beanbag

- Use the tape to make a simple hopscotch pattern on the floor. Open the Bible to 1 Corinthians 3:9 and lay today's marker on the page.
- Give a child the beanbag and invite her to toss it into a square of the hopscotch pattern. Encourage the child to hop on one foot, then two, to move through the pattern.
- At the end, show the child the Bible and point to the words on the marker. Help the child say the Bible verse.
- Tell the child to take another turn moving through the pattern. This time, help her say the Bible verse as she hops.

#### DRAW WITH CHALK OUTDOORS

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Paul's Second Journey (Pack Item 9), sidewalk chalk, Book: Paul Loved Jesus (Pack Item 29)

- Call the names of two or three children and invite them to go outdoors to draw with chalk. Remind the children they should walk quietly and slowly through the building.
- Take the Story Picture, Bible, and book with you. Look for a safe, shaded area.
- Give children time to use their imagination to draw on the sidewalk. Ask children to describe some of their pictures.
- After a while, sit together to look at the Story Picture.
   Picture-read the book to help children recall the story about Paul's journeys to tell people about Jesus.
- Return to the room and invite different children to go outdoors to draw.

#### **EXPLORE A BIBLE DICTIONARY**

Tools: Bible, Bible Place Names (Pack Item 28), New Testament Map (Pack Item 27), children's illustrated Bible dictionary, sticky note flags

- Before the session, locate pages in the dictionary showing places Paul visited on his missionary journeys. Mark the pages with note flags.
- Call children's attention to the Bible Places Names.
   Remark that these are places Paul visited to talk to people about Jesus.
- Comment: "Let's learn something about these places. We can use this Bible dictionary to help us."
- Tell children that a Bible dictionary gives helpful information about people, places, and things found in the Bible.
- Encourage children to look on the marked pages for information about some cities. Point out the cities on the New Testament Map.

#### PLAY WITH PEOPLE FIGURES

Tools: Bible, wooden blocks, toy people figures, Activity Page

- Give preschoolers room to build whatever they wish with blocks. Watch the children incorporate the people figures into their play.
- As children stack, build, and knock over blocks, affirm them for showing consideration for others. Tell them this is a way to work together.
- Show the picture on the Activity Page. Say: "Paul chose men to go with him on his missionary journeys. Everywhere Paul went, he told people about Jesus. Paul encouraged his friends to work together to tell people the good news about Jesus."

#### PLACE LETTERS ON A PAN

Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Paul Told Lydia About Jesus (Pack Item 10), ACTS Key Words (Music & Print Extras), magnetic alphabet letters, metal baking pan

- Use the *Go* and *Tell* Key Words to highlight today's Bible story and Text Truth. Lay the words on a table with the alphabet letters and metal pan.
- When a child shows interest in the letters, invite him to find letters to spell his name. Then show the child the Key Words and say them. Remark that today we have been learning that we should be ready to go and tell all people about Jesus.
- Ask: "Can you find letters to spell a word? Place the letters on the pan."
- While the preschooler looks for letters, show him the Story Picture and recall that Paul was ready to tell Lydia and her family about Jesus.

• Open the Bible to Acts 16 and help the child find the names *Lydia* and *Paul*.

#### **WORK PUZZLES & ANSWER QUESTIONS**

Tools: Bible, several puzzles featuring people, "W" Question Cards (Pack Item 32)

- Place the puzzles on a table with the Question Cards. Place the "W" side faceup near the Bible.
- Invite a child to choose a puzzle to work. Remark that all the puzzles show people who need to hear about Jesus. Say: "God wants us to be ready to talk to people of all ages and wherever we go to help the people know about His Son, Jesus."
- Engage other puzzle workers in thinking about who and what to tell people. Invite a child to turn over one Question Card. Read the question and help children decide the best response. Continue answering questions as long as children are interested.

#### **DECORATE A BIBLE VERSE PAGE**

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), colored paper, thick white paper, washable marker, glue sticks

- Before the session, write today's Bible verse on the heavyweight paper, making one paper for each preschooler. Put the Bible Verse Marker in the Bible at Titus 2:1.
- Invite preschoolers to tear small pieces of paper to glue on their papers. Children can make a design or randomly place the paper pieces on or around the Bible verse words.
- While children work on their verse pages, open the Bible to the marker. Say: "These words say to teach what is true. Paul wrote these words to his friend Titus."

- Show children the Story Picture and recall the story. Say: "Let's play out the Bible story. Who wants to be Paul? Silas? the guards?"
- After children volunteer, suggest they put Bible times clothing over their own and look in the mirror.
- Open the Bible to Acts 16 and tell the Bible story in your words while preschoolers play out the story.
- Encourage children to exchange roles or hand clothing items to others to have a turn to play out the story.

#### MAKE KEY RUBBINGS

Tools: Bible, variety of keys, thin paper, large crayons, masking tape, table or tray, Book: Paul Loved Jesus (Pack Item 29)

- Put rolled masking tape on one side of each key and tape it to a table or tray. Remove paper from the crayons.
- Direct a child to lay a piece of paper over the keys and rub over the paper using the flat side of the crayon. As the child rubs, the shape of the key will appear.
- After a child finishes, show him the book and the page showing Paul in jail. Comment: "The angry people locked Paul and Silas in chains when they put the men in jail. Later, God caused the chains to break open, so Paul and Silas were free."
- Summarize the Bible story, remarking that Paul and Silas helped the guard and others know that Jesus was the One who helped them.

#### **MOVE & SAY THE VERSE**

Tools: Bible, index cards, marker

- Write these action words on index cards: sway, wiggle, jump, clap, bend. Put the action cards next to the Bible opened to Acts 16.
- Say today's Bible verse. Help children say the verse.
- Direct a child to choose an action card. Read the action and tell the child to move that way while saying the Bible verse
- After several children have done actions and repeated the Bible verse, sit down with the Bible. Point to the verse at Acts 16:31.
- Say: "This verse helps us remember that Jesus is the One who helps us."

#### PLACE WORD CARDS IN ORDER

Tools: Bible, index cards, washable marker, handled gift bag, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16)

#### **BUILD WITH LETTER BLOCKS**

Tools: Bible; multiple wooden blocks with letters J, E, S, U, S (or write letters on squares of paper and tape them to blocks); Activity Page

- Scatter blocks on the floor. Arrange one block set to spell Jesus' name.
- Lead children to find and arrange another set of blocks with the same pattern of letters.
- Remark: "We used the blocks to spell Jesus' name. God wants us to love Jesus and tell about Him."
- Show children the picture on the Activity Page and comment that Paul never stopped telling about Jesus. Paul was a witness to others.
- Turn to Acts 22:15 and say today's verse. Remark: "We are witnesses when we love Jesus and tell others about Him."

#### **DECORATE A HEART SHAPE**

Tools: Bible, paper cut into large heart shapes, crayons, markers, dot markers, heart stamps, ink pad, Book: Paul Loved Jesus (Pack Item 29)

- Arrange the art supplies on a table and invite a few children to decorate heart shapes.
- Ask: "What do you think about when you see a heart shape? Love? Yes, hearts remind us of love. Today you have heard a story about Paul. Paul loved Jesus and told people about Jesus."
- Use the book to briefly summarize Paul's story.
- Encourage preschoolers to decorate their heart shapes however they wish. Write today's Bible verse or Text Truth on each child's heart shape.
- Ask children to whom they might give their heart pictures.

#### **MOVE TO SHAPES**

Tools: Bible, Bible Verse Markers (Pack Item 16), masking tape, Music & Print Extras

- Make tape shapes on the floor around the room. Make the shapes large enough for a child to stand in. Lay the Bible inside one shape.
- Say to children: "I am going to play music. Move around the room. When the music stops, move to a shape and stand still."

#### HOPSCOTCH TO A PICTURE


Tools: Bible, Story Picture: Paul's Stormy Journey (Pack Item 13), masking tape

- Use the tape to make a hopscotch grid on the floor. Make the sections larger than a child's foot. Alternate onesquare and two-square rows. Make six rows.
- Lay the Story Picture at the end of the grid.
- Guide a preschooler to hop on one foot, then two feet, and so on until he reaches the last row.
- Tell the preschooler to pick up the Story Picture and return to start. Review the Bible story when the child reaches you.

#### FLOAT & SINK OBJECTS


Tools: Bible, large pan with water, towel, objects to test in the water (plastic boat, small piece of wood or bark, rock, crayon, plastic block, leaf, straw, plastic lid), paper plate labeled It Floats and another plate labeled It Sinks, paper towels

- Spread the towel on a table and put the pan of water on it.
- Tell children: "The men on the boat were afraid the boat was going to sink. Let's test a few objects to see if they sink or float."
- Place one object in the water. It if floats, remove it to the *It Floats* plate. If the object sinks, place it on the *It Sinks* plate.
- Give children turns to test the objects.
- Say: "Boats are made to float on water though they are very heavy. Paul told the men to trust God to help them get through the storm."




STORY PICTURE PAGE 1: JESUS WASHED HIS FRIENDS' FEET


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STORY PICTURE PAGE 2: JESUS TALKED ABOUT VINES AND FRUIT

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



































### Drum

Gather empty coffee cans, cardboard oatmeal boxes, or shortening cans with lids. Cover containers with colorful paper or contact plastic.

Provide dowel rods or unsharpened pencils for tapping.




### **Tambourine**

Put a small amount of dried beans, dry rice, aquarium gravel, or other loose items in an aluminum pie pan. Place another pan on top and seal with colorful tape. Or punch holes around the edge of the two pans. Thread yarn through the holes and attach jingle bells.




### **Shakers**

Partially fill plastic salt and pepper shakers with items such as dried beans, pebbles, paper clips, or other loose items. Seal the caps with wide tape.



### **Cymbals**

Offer same-size saucepan lids with handles for a child to clap together.

Use dental floss to sew jingle bells onto large elastic ponytail scrunchies.



# Rhythm Blocks


Glue sandpaper to the sides of wooden blocks for children to rub together.

Offer wooden spoons to tap together.




### Gong


