Sin separates us from God.



GARDEN OF EDEN VALANCE

There are lots of ways to tell stories. You could use words, music, dancing, or crayons. This valance **TELLS A STORY WITH METAL THREAD!**

A valance is a short curtain for the top of a window. This one belongs to a set of three valances and is over **400 YEARS OLD**. The artist used metal thread to stitch silk shapes—leaves, animals, fruit, people—onto one long piece of velvet. It shows **TWO SCENES FROM GENESIS 3**—when God calls to Adam and Eve after they sin and when they leave Eden.



The entire valance is 6 1/2 feet long!
