
ADAM AND EVE'S SIN

GARDEN OF EDEN VALANCE

There are many ways to tell stories. You could use words, instruments, dancing, or paint. This valance **TELLS A STORY USING METAL THREAD!**

A valance is a short curtain for the top of a window or canopy bed. This one belongs to a set of three valances and is more than 400 YEARS OLD. The artist used metal thread to stitch silk shapes-leaves,

> animals, fruit, people—onto one long piece of velvet. It shows TWO SCENES FROM GENESIS 3—when God calls to the hiding couple after they sin and when Adam and Eve leave Eden.

How do you like to tell stories?


