Offerings are GIFTS GIVEN TO GOD. Today, we give money. In Bible times, God's people gave many kinds of offerings, like ANIMALS, **CROPS, PRECIOUS METALS, SPICES, AND** LINEN. The first offerings in the Bible were given by the world's first brothers, Cain and Abel. This ivory plaque shows them giving their offerings. The plaque was sculpted in Italy. Today, it's displayed in the **LOUVRE MUSEUM IN PARIS, FRANCE.** This piece of art is more than 900 YEARS OLD.
