CENTRAL TRUTH

False teachers will be judged, but believers will be sustained and protected by God.

KEY QUESTION

→ **What should believers remember to help combat false teachings?**

We would do well to remember not only the warnings but also to hold tight to the true gospel. The way we do that is by being regularly reading God's Word and being around other believers who can help us to navigate and discern what we are hearing and being taught.

KEEP IN MIND

- Emphasize the one true gospel. It will also be helpful to briefly address some popular false teachings that students may find themselves confronted with today. Use the **Culture Note** as a guide as you unpack some false teachings that students may have heard before and what the Bible truly says.
- While we're called to be vigilant, we don't need to live in fear of false teachers that arise. The Lord is the one who sustains us, ensuring that we will one day stand in His presence, blameless and with great joy. When we anchor our lives with the truth of God's Word, we combat false teaching.

APPLICATION

- **How does the book of Jude motivate you to share the gospel within your circle of influence?**

THE WIN

FOR THE STUDENT: We are sustained by God and can combat false teaching through reminding ourselves of the one true gospel and allowing God's Word to anchor us.
