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Prayer Guide

Fall 2026: Romans

Session 1 — Week of September 6, 2026

Read Romans 1:13-25, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Pray that you would never be ashamed of the gospel. Ask God to deepen your confidence in the power of the gospel.
- Pray specifically for those you know that need salvation. Ask God to give you the opportunity and courage to share your faith with them.
- Make a list of God's invisible attributes that make up His eternal power and divine nature. Praise him for those attributes one by one.
- Ask God to give you an understanding of the seriousness of sin in our broken world.
- Ask God to search you and show you the areas of your life where you have replaced worshiping and serving the Creator with worshiping and serving what has been created.



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Session 2 — Week of September 13, 2026

Read Romans 2:1-13, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Pray for humility in your life that recognizes your own sin before condemning others.
- Confess the areas of your life where you regularly depend on your own strength and wisdom instead of God's strength and wisdom.
- Ask God to give you perseverance in doing good and seeking to honor Him through your life.
- Pray that God would give you the strength to not show favoritism just as God does not show favoritism.
- Pray for God to open the hearts of those who have rejected Him.

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Session 3 — Week of September 20, 2026

Read Romans 3:21–4:5, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Praise God for the righteousness He gives to us through Jesus.
- Pray that the enemy will not gain a foothold in your life through doubt and guilt. Ask God to remind you consistently of His grace and mercy.
- Confess to God the reality of your hopelessness without Him.
- Thank God for His grace and mercy that allows you to spend eternity with Him.
- Pray that the peace God grants to you through Jesus will empower you to love your neighbors without fear.



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Session 4 — Week of September 27, 2026

Read Romans 5:1-11, 18-21, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Ask the Lord to help you rest in the peace of salvation He has given to you through Jesus.
- Think of specific trials or difficulties you are facing right now. Ask the Lord to give you patience in those trials. Ask the Lord to help you see those areas where He is developing endurance, character, and hope through your difficulties.
- Give thanks to the Lord for sending Jesus to die for us while we were still helpless.
- Ask the Lord to remove anything that is preventing grace from reigning in your heart today. Pray that the grace of God will move you to live righteously as you wait for Christ's return.



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Session 5 — Week of October 4, 2026

Read Romans 6:1-14, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Praise God for the eternal victory over sin that Jesus's resurrection accomplished.
- Ask God to give you the strength to let go of familiar sins that are hindering your relationship with Him.
- Pray Jesus's power over sin would rule your life in the decisions you make every day.
- Ask God to reveal where you are allowing areas of your life to be used as a weapon for unrighteousness. Write those areas down and surrender each of them to God to be used as a weapon for righteousness.
- Pray God would give you the ability to live boldly with joyful, daily obedience because sin's mastery over you has been broken by Jesus.

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Session 6 — Week of October 11, 2026

Read Romans 7:4-6,14-25, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Give thanks to the Lord that you now belong to Him.
- Ask the Lord to make your life overflow with fruit that glorifies Him.
- Ask the Lord to show you every lingering passion from your life before Christ and to put it to death through the Spirit's power.
- Ask the Lord to give you the strength to do the good you want to do instead of the evil you do not want to do.
- Thank God for the certainty of your salvation through Jesus.



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Session 7 — Week of October 18, 2026

Read Romans 8:14-27, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Approach the Father in prayer as a child of God. Speak to Him about every aspect of your life.
- Pray that you would live daily in the freedom that comes from Christ and not return to the life of fear.
- Pray that you will trust the Spirit's testimony about your life with God regardless of the circumstances of your life.
- Pray for steadfast hope even as you wait for the promised return of Jesus.
- Trust in the Spirit to intercede on your behalf. Even when words escape you, pray and allow the Spirit to interpret your intentions to the Father.



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Session 8 — Week of October 25, 2026

Read Romans 9:30–10:3, 9-17, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Ask the Lord to reveal to you the areas of your life where you are still depending on your own moral goodness instead of trusting in the grace of God.
- Pray that the Lord will continually confirm the assurance of your salvation, knowing it is dependent on His power, promises, and provision in Jesus and not your effort.
- Pray for those who are still striving to earn God's acceptance through religion rather than trusting in His grace.
- Pray specifically for people in your circle of influence who have not yet trusted Jesus as their Savior.
- Ask the Lord to give you the courage to be a bold witness for Him in every area of your life.

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Session 9 — Week of November 1, 2026

Read Romans 11:11-24, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Praise God for His grace in extending salvation to all nations.
- Pray for a heart that longs for the salvation of other people.
- Pray for humility in your walk with the Lord. Ask the Lord to protect you from pride, self-righteousness, and spiritual superiority.
- Pray for unity among the believers of God. Ask the Lord to continue to bring together people from all nations through salvation into a unified family of God.
- Ask God to guard you from becoming careless in your faith. Pray for a sensitive heart that is continually seeking renewal from the Lord.



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Session 10 — Week of November 8, 2026

Read Romans 12:1-3, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Ask the Lord to reveal and remove obstacles preventing you from fully surrendering your life as a sacrifice to the Lord.
- Pray for the Lord to renew your mind through His Word so that your values, attitudes, actions, and words might be transformed. Pray for help to discern the good and perfect will of the Father.
- Pray for unity in your local church and the global church.
- Ask the Lord to reveal your spiritual gifts and to open doors for you to be able to use those gifts to build up the church and serve the Kingdom of God.
- Pray to live a life of sincere love that reflects the love shown to us by God.



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Session 11 — Week of November 15, 2026

Read Romans 13:1-14, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Ask God to give you a heart that desires to submit to authorities God has placed in your life.
- Pray for local, state, and national governmental leaders. Ask the Lord to give them wisdom, justice, humility, and discernment.
- Ask the Lord to give you some practical ways you can demonstrate love to your neighbors.
- Pray to put on the character of Christ and to put aside the deeds of darkness.
- Ask the Lord to help you remain faithful to Him and His calling in these days as we wait for the Lord's return.

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Session 12 — Week of November 22, 2026

Read Romans 14:5-20, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Pray for patience with fellow believers. Pray for the strength to not judge a fellow believer's conscience.
- Pray that love will rule your decisions even if that means limiting your own Christian liberty so you do not become a stumbling block to others.
- Pray that you will focus on the true priorities of God's kingdom. Ask God to protect you and the church from getting caught in secondary debates.
- Ask God to protect the unity of the church.
- Pray to live a life that encourages and strengthens the faith of the people around you.

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Session 13 — Week of November 29, 2026

Read Romans 15:14-21,30-33, then respond to these questions:

- How does God reveal Himself in these verses?
- How should I respond to what He reveals?

Pray

- Thank God for equipping you with everything you need to accomplish His will.
- Pray for courage to boldly proclaim the Gospel and to faithfully serve wherever God calls you.
- Pray for missionaries around the world. Pray that God would protect them spiritually and make their ministry fruitful among the nations.
- Pray for your pastors and spiritual leaders. Pray for God's protection, wisdom, and favor in their lives.
- Ask God to give you grace to stand firm in your faith while you rest in the assurance that the God of peace will keep you secure.
